You can only take one spare battery (separated) in carry-on not exceeding 100 watt-hours, or two spare batteries, not exceeding 160 watt-hours ...

Medications and baby formula are exceptions but must be declared. Batteries and Electronic Devices: Lithium batteries (under 100 watt-hours) must be carried in your hand luggage. Larger batteries may ...

They're limited to a rating of 100 watt hours (Wh) per battery. With airline approval, you can bring two larger spare batteries (up to 160 Wh).

So, what is the correct way to travel with your lithium battery-powered devices? Always keep lithium batteries with you in your carry-on baggage, never in your checked luggage.
