With the discovery of Eris in 2005, after 150 years as the head of the asteroid belt, Ceres became the solar system's smallest dwarf planet. Ceres is still the largest, ...

In 2008, Haumea, discovered in 2004, and Makemake, discovered in 2005, were recognized as dwarf planets, for a total of five officially recognized dwarf planets.

Discovered by Clyde Tombaugh in 1930, Pluto was long considered our solar system's ninth planet. But after other astronomers found similar ...

The first dwarf planet discovered was Ceres, spotted in 1801 by Italian astronomer Giuseppe Piazzi. Originally considered the first asteroid, Ceres orbits between ...
